President's column

What is the credit union doing during this economic slowdown?

If you think like me, then you are likely waiting for any positive economic news to brighten your day. There just isn't very much good news, though, is there?

The good news that I can and will talk about is the advantage that you have as a credit union member. You are able to rest knowing that the credit union, as a member owned cooperative, has your best interest at heart and will keep that in mind when we make decisions in the midst of the recession.

While banks are raising fees and increasing minimum balances to combat their negative earnings, your credit union said "No!" We have not increased any fees or charges that would negatively impact you during these tough times. Our checking account has no minimum balance and no per item fees.

When banks stopped lending money in our community, your credit union said "That's not right!" We have continued to loan money to our members for homes, cars, and credit cards at some of the lowest rates available. There continues to be no "credit crunch" here. If your car or truck has less than 60,000 miles and is less than six years old, we will give you a new car rate. Will your bank do that?

Deposits are safe, sound and insured.

At Greenville Federal Credit Union, all share accounts are safe, sound and federally insured by NCUA. All members of federally insured credit unions are provided with \$250,000 in share insurance coverage for individual accounts and additional coverage for multiple accounts. Individual accounts include regular shares (savings), share drafts (checking), yield-plus accounts and share certificates (CDs). This coverage was set to expire at the end of 2009, but has been extended through December 31, 2013.

The National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) is the federal government agency that charters and supervises federal credit unions. NCUA also operates and manages the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund (NCUSIF). Backed by the full faith and credit of the U.S. government, NCUSIF insures the accounts of millions of account holders in all federal credit unions and the vast majority of state-chartered credit unions.

When you read the newspaper about banks accepting TARP funds from the government, rest assured that your credit union is not receiving a direct government bailout. Credit unions located in California, Florida, Nevada, and Arizona are hurting right now. But the credit union system supports itself. We have never received taxpayer funds like the banks and savings and loans and we never will. We are proud of this fact and we hope that you are too.

When you read about banks needing to raise more capital, know that your credit union is well capitalized and is prepared to deal with this economic downturn. That is what capital is for...capital helps you get through the rainy days. Although we anticipate that some of our members may see tough times in the months ahead, we are confident that we will work closely with our members so that they will continue to prosper in the future.

Rest easy tonight, and every night, knowing that your credit union will always do what is right for you. After all, you own us.

If you forget or miscalculate something, Courtesy Pay saves you time, money and embarrassment from having a Non-Sufficient Fund (NSF) item returned to a merchant.

Your checking account must be brought to a positive balance at least once within a 30-day period to maintain the Courtesy Pay protection privilege. This new safety feature is designed to help prevent international fraud when you least expect it. Please contact a member service representative during normal business hours if you plan on traveling outside the U.S. in the future. And don't forget to let us know when you plan on returning to help block future fraud from happening.
